important information

conditions of entry

Completing the entry form and paying the entry fee means that you accept the following conditions:

- The 2005 Air New Zealand World Rugby Festival is an invitation event and the Golden Oldies World Secretariat will only accept entries on this basis.
- 2. All players must be 35 years or older on 15 May 2005.
- 3. All teams travelling by air must travel on Air New Zealand services or other approved Star Alliance or partner carrier(s). Details will be provided as entries are received.
- 4. All teams must complete a form listing all team members' names and addresses (whether players or supporters) once the entry has been accepted.
- 5. All entries will be subject to acceptance by the World Secretariat, which reserves the right to decline or withdraw any entry at any time, should it consider there is non-compliance with the "Conditions of Entry". If a team is so rejected, any refund of ground package payments will only be made in accordance with the Festival payment schedule and refund rules applying to all teams.
- 6. The World Secretariat reserves the right to determine the maximum number of entries from any one country.
- 7. Entries will close on 28 February 2005 or at any other time at the discretion of the World Secretariat.
- 8. Entries will be accepted from clubs, groups or individuals who wish to form a Golden Oldies team.

waiver, release and indemnification

In consideration of our team's acceptance for entry in the 15th Air New Zealand Golden Oldies World Rugby Festival ("the event"):

- 1. All members of our team named below ("we") hereby agree to comply with the Conditions of Entry and with all rules and regulations and event instructions of the Festival and its Directors.
- We and our executors, administrators, heirs, next of kin, successors and assigns, HEREBY

a) Waive and release the Festival, its Event Committee, their officers, directors, members, volunteers, employees, agents, sponsors, the city of San Diego and any and all of their executors, administrators, heirs, next of kin, successors or assigns ("the releases") from any and all claims whatsoever we may have against the releases arising out of our participation in the event and its related activities, together with any costs including lawyers' fees that may be incurred as a result of any such claim whether valid or not, and
b) indemnify and hold harmless the releases individually and collectively against any such claims that we or our guests may have or assert against them in respect of any costs including Lawyers' fees with respect thereto.

- 3. We hereby acknowledge that we have sole responsibility for our personal possessions and sporting equipment during the Festival, and its related activities and will make no claim against the releases in respect of any loss or damage to the equipment.
- 4. We hereby acknowledge that participation in the Festival carries with it potential hazard. We therefore release and indemnify the Festival, its Event Committee, their officers, directors, members, volunteers, employees, sponsors from any and all liability resulting from the injury, accident, illness or death during the event and its related activities.

- 9. Participants not normally resident in San Diego County must take an accommodation package. Other teams may purchase a local package.
- 10. All teams must complete the official entry form in this brochure.
- 11. Air New Zealand reserves the right to change any venue of the Festival or any part thereof, including its removal to another country if in its absolute discretion it determines such a measure is necessary by reason of changed circumstances or conditions existing or anticipated at the Festival venue.

Air New Zealand Limited acts only as agents for the providers of ground services included in this package and will not be liable for any injury, cost damage, expense, loss or delay which may be sustained or occasioned by reason of the negligence or default of any person or sub-contractor engaged to provide such services.

Unforeseen circumstances may necessitate the lengthening or shortening of the Festival and in such cases adjustment to the cost of the package will be on a pro-rata basis. No refund will be made for any unused portion of the full Festival package.

The passenger ticket when issued by the airline concerned shall constitute the sole contract between the Carrier concerned and the passenger and carriage by air will be subject to the actual Carrier's Conditions of Carriage.

- 5. We hereby consent to receive medical treatment provided or arranged by any authorised representative of the Festival which such representative may deem necessary in the event of injury, accident or illness we may sustain during the Festival.
- 6. We hereby consent to the free use of our names and pictures in broadcasts, telecasts and press statements or reports as they pertain to the Festival.
- 7. We acknowledge that all members of our team must have health and injury insurance and that each member of the group may be required to confirm this in writing if required to do so by the World Secretariat.

- International or domestic airfares
- Meals and drinks other than those specified in the programme
- Airport departure taxes
- Items of a personal nature such as telephone calls, laundry, liquor (other than that supplied at the social functions), room service etc.
- Air travel security and insurance levies.
- Porterage
- Travel and medical insurance.
- Any additional taxes that may be in place at the time of the Festival.

local package

A special package will be available for individual team members normally resident in San Diego County. It will include tickets to the Welcome Party and Grand Finale Dinner and a Festival Souvenir but will not include transport.

The members of those teams qualifying by reason of their residency are required to purchase a local package if they wish to play in Festival games.

As a condition of entry, teams will be asked to supply participant residential addresses. Full details will be sent to teams that qualify as a local team.

your entry guide

Entries: Entries must be on the official entry form attached to this brochure and accompanied by the team entry fee of US\$230 (US Dollar Bank draft) made payable to the "2005 Golden Oldies World Rugby Festival". The entry fee can also be paid by credit card (Visa or MasterCard only) - see Entry Form for details. Number of Players/Teams: You can enter more than one team if you have sufficient players. The entry team will apply to each team entry. Individuals may also enter and play in a team of their choice or be allocated to a pool team.

Referees: We encourage teams to include an experienced referee



in their number. Visiting and local referees will control the matches. The local committee will provide details about the level of referee required.

Friends, Families and Non-Playing Supporters: Non-playing family members and friends are welcome at the San Diego Rugby Festival. They are included as members of your team group Cancellations and Refunds of Team Entry Fees: We understand that occasionally unforeseen circumstances may force teams to withdraw from the Festival. To be as fair as possible, a

cancellation policy has been adopted for the refund of team entry fees:

Up to March 31, 2004	-	Full refund.
From April 1 to December 31, 2004	-	50% refund.
After December 31, 2004	-	No refund.

Note: If a team cancels and some individual members still want to attend they will be welcome as individual entrants.

insurance

Adequate personal and medical insurance must be arranged for every member of your group which covers injuries, hospitalisation or medical treatment arising from illness or injury whether on or off the field. We strongly recommend that insurance cover is also taken out for loss of property, travel delays etc.

the organisation

Golden Oldies Rugby matches are especially for players aged 35 years and over. It provides enjoyment for players of all ages and focuses on participation rather than winning. Each team plays three games during the Festival and the strongest competition may lie in the novel playing gear or the rehearsed and spontaneous performances teams bring to the Festival. The Golden Oldies movement is co-ordinated in New Zealand by a Secretariat under the auspices of Air New Zealand. Guidelines in

the form of a Team Manager's Manual, destination videos, brochures, posters, newsbriefs and other publicity material will be available.
